Copley conversion

Just as Back Bay's moneyed socialites need a facelift every few years, so do the neighborhood's historic landmarks. The **Copley Square Hotel** (47 Huntington Avenue, Boston, 617.536.9000), the city's second oldest hotel in continuous operation, closed in mid January for a \$14 million renovation, and it's expected to reopen in late spring. When it does, the four-star boutique hotel will feature a striking, tech-forward lobby; 143 newly redesigned rooms done up in a soothing palette of cream, chocolate, and taupe; and XHALE, a casual breakfast and dinner hangout for guests in need of a quick bite. Adjacent nightspot Saint will remain open during hotel construction, and Domani Bar & Trattoria will reopen in late February after a few minor tweaks.
